TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDERS

Esplanade and Battery Slipway, Sandown (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic and Pedestrians) that from approx. 0700 hours on Monday 2 March 2020 until 2100 hours on Wednesday 4 March 2020, or when the works have been completed, no person shall cause any vehicle or pedestrian, to proceed along Esplanade and Battery Slipway, between its junctions with Pier Street and Esplanade Road.
